2021 THM Landscape Committee Report

Due to the CIP Project throughout this year, some common area plans were put on hold. However, with the help of several resident volunteers, the following activities were completed:

Common Area Maintenance:

5.12.2021: Colorful caladiums brightened up the Stonehouse alley side of the pool grounds as well as three container arrangements contributed by a resident volunteer. 6.3.2021: Two resident volunteers cut up and removed major branches that fell in Courtyard E (Breakwood) after a wind event.

11.18.2021: Three resident volunteers cleaned the rose bed at the south end of Courtyard A (Bassoon), trimmed the roses and added MicroLife 6-2-4 fertilizer and compost

11.28.2021: Five resident volunteers trimmed dead branches, etc. from the hedge on the alley side of Courtyard C by 4139 Meyerwood. MicroLife 6-2-4 fertilizer and compost were added.

Irrigation:

9.10.2021: Irrigation system was installed along the west side of Courtyard A (Bassoon). This is expected to significantly improve the health of the landscape at this site. 10.23.2021: Irrigation system was installed by THM and Woodshire volunteers along the grassy strip entrance (and the new sidewalk!). Special thanks to the many volunteers (young and not so young) who, under Jeff's guidance, completed this significant effort.

Community Contributions:

In addition to donating their expertise and sweat-equity, many owners sent monetary donations to help to enhance our common areas post CIP. We have used some of the funds to install charcoal black landscaping pavers and to remove some shrubbery along Breakwood Dr. and alley F.
