Below is a list of committees with their description. Joining any of THMs committees is a great opportunity to meet your neighbors, serve your community and get involved with neighborhood activities. **Please initial next to the committee(s) on which you would be willing to participate and provide your contact information below.**

Ongoing committees:

_____ **Pool Committee** – The pool committee helps maintain the pool area. You will be involved with maintenance of the pool grounds, evaluation of vendors and recommending capital improvement expenditures.

_____ **Architectural Review Committee** – The architectural review committee is responsible for the review of homeowner’s requests to modify the exterior of their home. Simple requests do not normally require committee involvement; you will participate in reviewing more complicated or controversial requests.

_____ **Landscape Committee** – The landscape committee manages our common areas to keep our grounds in tip top shape. You will help with capital projects and vendor relations.

_____ **Social Committee** – The social committee will plan recreation and social events and will assist with welcoming new neighbors and providing needed information.

_____ **Utilities Committee** – This committee will coordinate with the City of Houston and monitor progress of the Capital Improvement Project (CIP) to replace our underground utilities, streets and sidewalks in 2019/2020. The committee meets periodically with our council member’s staff, public works officials and CenterPoint representatives.

_____ **Deed Restriction Committee** – This committee works with and educates homeowners to assure all homes in THM are in compliance with our deed restrictions. Participation will include surveying individual town homes from a street/courtyard view and an alley view and identifying violations.

_____ **Safety**--This committee is charged with identifying security issues within our community and researching/developing plans to enhance personal and community safety.

_____ **Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR)** –This committee is charged with identifying THM’s stray/feral cat population and providing humane methods to manage this population.
