

Townhouse Manor Landscape Committee

2019 Report

Due to the CenterPoint gas line replacement project, our common area flower beds (Fordshire, Stonehouse and Meyerwood/Bassoon entrances) were not maintained as originally planned. Upon completion of the CIP project (expected late 2021), development and care of these areas will resume.

Focus has been on:

- 1) the care of rose beds at the south end of Bassoon courtyard, Meyerwood/Bassoon entrance and Breakwood 3 courtyard,
- 2) the pool grounds and
- 3) the trimming and/or removal of diseased and damaged trees.

Following the City of Houston repair of a major water leak in Breakwood 2 courtyard, the entire courtyard was aerated and the soil amended with gypsum and compost. Fallen leaves from the courtyard's trees and chips from the ground stump remain as mulch for the barren soil in hopes of improving the soil naturally, without use of chemicals.

Volunteers are always welcome so please consider joining this committee and assisting with our 2020 projects.
